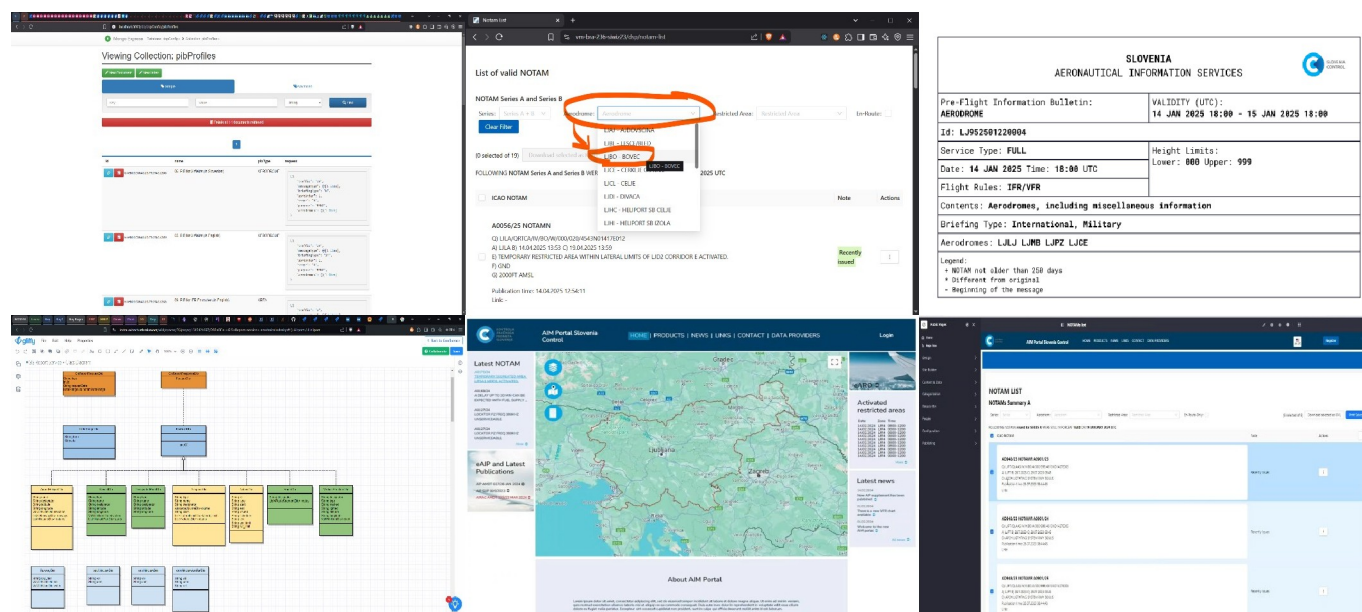
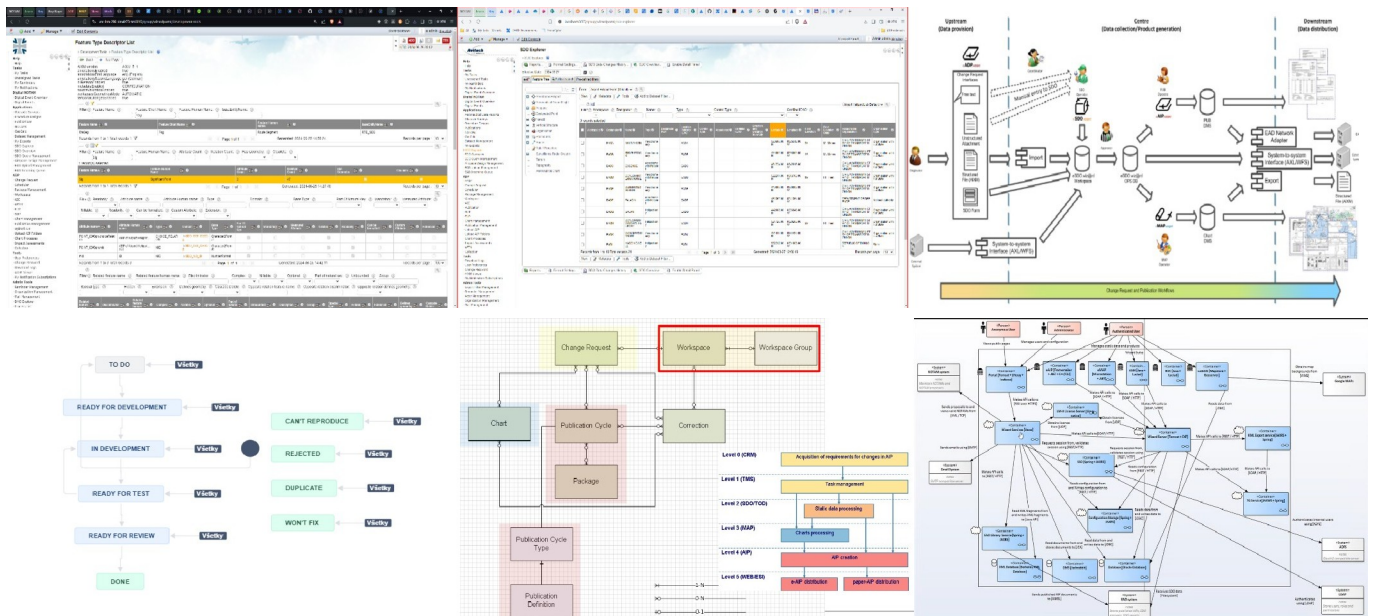


Overview of Projects and Use Cases Delivered Throughout the Company's History

- Project description** : The DSP (Downstream Portal) project is a public aviation platform designed to provide pilots with access to various reports and data. It displays ICAO NOTAMs and restricted areas on an interactive GIS map, allowing users to visualize important aviation information. The portal consolidates information from multiple service providers, including AIM, AIMSL, METAR, SNOWTAM, TAR, and PIB. It highlights designated points and zones, offering detailed information about their status and relevance. This system serves as a practical tool for pilots to stay informed about airspace restrictions and operational conditions.
- Participation / Role** : Joined a business-critical project that was already approximately three months behind schedule and took ownership of key development activities required to restore delivery momentum. Quickly onboarded into a new business domain through collaboration with long-tenured subject matter experts, analysis of existing codebases, and review of available technical and business documentation. Designed and implemented integrations between frontend, middleware, and backend systems for deployment on the client's SIWIZ platform. Developed a Quarkus-based DSP backend API, extended an existing React application with new screens and components, and configured CI/CD pipelines using SonarQube and Jenkins. Worked closely with the Product Owner to translate business requirements into deliverable solutions and accelerate project recovery.

These forums provided opportunities to align on best practices, address technical questions, and define strategic directions for solving issues across multiple projects.

Within three months of joining the project, delivered a functional end-to-end prototype for customer review, enabling validation of key business and technical requirements. Achieved rapid domain proficiency despite having no prior experience in the subject area by leveraging knowledge transfer from senior experts, self-study of technical documentation, and analysis of the existing solution architecture. Subsequently delivered MVP within the revised project schedule (May 2024), completed stabilization and enhancement of Phase 1 functionality by September 2024, delivered Phase 2 development by September 2025, and supported production release readiness activities.

Beyond my responsibilities as a Senior Developer, I worked closely with stakeholders, Product Owners, Business Analysts, the Lead Architect, and DevOps engineers to understand business objectives and align technical solutions with long-term strategic goals. In addition to software development, I contributed in a Solution Architect capacity by designing technical solutions, evaluating architectural options, and translating business requirements into actionable development tasks. I prepared and refined Jira epics, stories, and technical tasks to support efficient backlog management and implementation by the development team. I led initiatives to improve code quality, maintainability, and system performance by promoting clean-code practices, SOLID principles, and sound object-oriented design. I drove refactoring efforts to reduce technical debt, simplify complex implementations, improve separation of concerns, and establish consistent architectural patterns across the codebase. I actively identified opportunities to improve application performance and scalability while optimizing operational and cloud-related costs. I collaborated with architecture and infrastructure teams to evaluate technical trade-offs and recommend sustainable long-term solutions.
